

Three Lions Qualify For World Junior Championships

Karelle Edwards, Micheal Robertson and Sekou Kaba all qualified for the World Junior Championships to be held Bydgoszcz, Poland. Edwards and Kaba continue their summer of fantastic form after capturing OFSAA Championships. Robertson comes off an impressive CIS rookie campaign.

Edwards achieved the Athletics Canada selection standard of 14.17 twice this year running 14.06 at the Brooks Twilight Meet #2, and 13.99 at the OTFA Supermeet held in Ottawa. The impressive eighteen year old collared two wins (100m Hurdles and Long Jump) at the 2008 OFSAA Championships held in Hamilton, Ontario and has been cultivating a storybook season

Robertson, the 300m Silver medalist at the 2008 CIS Championships, has also had a strong season to date. The nineteen year old ran 21.43 dipping under the Athletics Canada selection standard of 21.50 at the Olympic Prep Invitational in Ottawa. He has achieved the IAAF standard in the 400m

Seventeen year old Kaba has been quite a revelation this season. The six foot two inch athlete has handled all comers this year not losing a final. He has been very impressive in handling a strong OFSAA field and posting a personal best of 13.92 seconds at the very competitive OTFA Supermeet.

All three athletes look to be favorites at Canadian National Junior Championships to be held in Abbotsford, BC from July 25-27.
