Job Description:

The Ottawa Lions Track and Field Club is seeking Summer Youth Camp Counsellors in Ottawa, Ontario. The position(s) will cover full time work over a span of 9 weeks during the months of June, July and August. The positions require commitment of a full day 8:00am-4:00pm Monday-Friday. Part time positions also available for ½ day 9:00am-1:00pm camps and supply if needed.

All camp activities will take place at the Terry Fox Athletic Facility/Mooneys Bay.

Our summer camps can attract up to 100 athletes in a week, ranging from 7 years of age to 14. Our goal is to establish and build a lifelong love for the sport of Track and Field while challenging youth to take part in the fundamentals of all events.

The candidate will have a passion for both teaching and the sport of athletics. The care, creativity and energy they bring to the position will have a lasting impact on the youth they will interact with and instill a lifelong love for the sport and healthy active living.

Duties include; the preparation and instruction of daily camp activities, care and supervision of campers. Counsellors will be expected to work independently and as a team. They will need to bring a positive, energetic and creative approach to coaching athletes that have a wide range of abilities and ages.

Qualifications:

The position is open to senior high school, university or college students or graduates with a preference for those looking to or currently studying kinesiology, physical education, sports management or recreation. Candidates should demonstrate experience and background in track and field, knowledge of French and English and experience working with children ages 7 - 14. Candidates with certification or training in NCCP RJTW will be given priority (sport and club coach certification are beneficial). CPR/First Aid will also be considered an asset. Candidates over 18 must supply a valid Police Check.
